Website Template Project

In July, U3A Murrindindi East was the first U3A to go live with a new website created through Network's Website Template Project. Murrindindi East has allowed Network to publicise their URL as an example where other U3As can see outputs from the template generator software. Check out <https://murrindindieastu3a.org.au>

Working with Network's Website Template Project support team, U3A Sale has also used the website generator to create their first ever website. This, too, is available for other U3As to review at <https://u3asale.org.au>



The Website Template Project is concentrating initially on those U3As still reliant for publicity on community portals or on the Network Office, but any U3As with an interest in upgrading or re-designing their site can find out more by contacting the Network Office.

There is no cost to use to template. Smaller U3As with up to 200 members can choose to be hosted through the Network's own facility at no cost, or any U3A can engage its own hosting service.

VMIA Insurance Policies

Community sector insurance policies for the 2017-2018 financial year have now been emailed to incorporated U3As directly from our State Government insurer, VMIA.

Those U3As who are not incorporated are covered by their membership of U3A Network. Some U3As choose to be auspiced by a local government body; but through one channel or another, all U3As have coverage.

These policies cover such risks as public liability, directors' liability, and volunteers' accident insurance for injuries incurred while volunteering.

Network Victoria has emailed to all Member U3As the VMIA presentation materials covered at the June Council meeting. U3As who want to learn more about VMIA and its coverage can go to the agency's website www.VMIA.com.

VMIA policies do not cover general member accident risk.

U-MAS User Group Meeting 5 October

Understanding Dementia

The Understanding Dementia MOOC is a *free* 9 week online course run by the University of Tasmania's Wicking Dementia Research and Education Centre. The curriculum addresses this health issue by drawing upon the expertise of neuroscientists, clinicians and dementia care professionals from both within the Wicking Centre and beyond.

The next course, Understanding Dementia, opened on 25 July, with enrolments open to 18 August.

Treasurers Corner

EFT Payments – A reminder to all treasurers processing online EFT payments into the U3A Network Victoria account, please ensure you have entered an invoice reference number or a very short text to indicate the purpose of your deposit. I have also received recently, several EFT payments from members, who have either overpaid or underpaid their capitation invoices. Please ensure you have proper training for those volunteers performing online EFT payments at your offices.

New Member - Pending the formalisation of our new U3A - Mirboo North & District Inc., I would like to welcome the treasurer, Colin Goodwin, to our community. Colin along with his new steering committee have been busy getting their new U3A up and running. This will take our total membership to 107 across Victoria.

Budgets - For those members who run their books on a 30 June financial year, you may now be contemplating your budget overview for the new 2017/18 financial year. I would like to remind those treasurers not to factor in any previous grants sourced via Network eg PGSF and ACFE. This does not mean the Government grants have stopped all together. The new process of disbursing these grants has changed radically. Network is currently working through the new processes and resourcing for the ACFE grant. We are yet to renegotiate a new PGSF grant contract with the Government, which will be effective from 1 July 2017. Look out for further grant details to be released by Network president in the near future.

Regional bankers (PGSF 2016/17 Regional Grants) - These grants were fully distributed to all 12 regions by 30 June 2017 and we do not have any more funding until a new contract is renegotiated with the Government. Thanks to all the treasurers/office staff who have volunteered to be the banker/recipient. Please continue to maintain the records of those expenditures in case the Government conducts an audit. In most cases, regional bankers have spent the whole grant within 6-12 months from point of receipt. Any surplus funds should be spent on related workshops/functions benefiting the region members and not carried forward, year after year.
