Exceedingly different to previous cemetery Rambles. A stunning 169 Hectare, 118 year-old memorial park incorporating many beautiful and diverse gardens and other interesting features. Easy meandering, regular toilets, some gentle gradients, 4-5 km. Bring a picnic, or coffee/lunch at Café Vita.

Enter **Main Drive** at 600 Princes Highway, Springvale 3171. For parking, **FOLLOW BLUE LINE ON ROAD**. It will take you beyond the buildings to a sweeping **160 degree left turn** into **6th Avenue**. Proceed down 6th Avenue and enter one of the two signposted parking areas off to your left.

On foot, continue through the carpark to **3rd Avenue West** and meet at **10:00am opposite the building housing the Blair and Wilson Chapels**. (hard copies of this pdf map will be distributed)
